Exploration Tutoring and

Mentoring Program

This program works to identify and pair students in grades 5 to 12 who are in need of academic support and/or positive adult relationships with volunteer mentors in the community.

Exploration grades K-4 Afterschool/Summer Program

This is an out-of-school commu-

nity collaboration offered in Wallowa and Enterprise four days per week from October to mid-April.

The Exploration summer program is science-based and is offered to youth in grades K-4 in Wallowa.

Youth Entrepreneurship Project

This targets individual skills and interests of Wallowa County's high school junior and seniors.

Books Bridging Generations

This program pairs students in grades K-3 in all three school districts with community volunteers for weekly reading sessions.

Estimated youth served each year is 80, along with 50 volun-

teers.

Alternative Ed

Enterprise Alternative Education provides tutoring and mentoring for high school students.
