### **Prevention Program Collaborative**

The PPC is a community partnership formed to advise and plan implementation of Prevention Services and Problem Gambling under the requirements of the Service Element 70 & 80 funding from the Oregon Department of Human Services, Addictions and Mental Health Division. The Collaborative, led by Building Healthy Families, will seek to facilitate the use of integrated strategies to prevent substance abuse and associated effects, regardless of the age of participants, using one or more of the following strategies: Information dissemination such as media campaigns; prevention education such as school curricula and parenting education; alcohol, tobacco and other drug free alternatives such as youth leadership and community service projects; community based processes such as community coalitions; environmental/social policy development such as school policies and community laws related to alcohol, tobacco and other drugs; and problem identification and referral such as student assistance programs.
